I am now confident that Team KEE will continue to provide the excellent and costeffective work needed to maintain our community.


When you see them at work, stop and take the time to thank them. They will welcome it!

This WSL Championship Tour Event offers spectators the chance to see the best on the big and challenging swell that often occurs at Pipeline in late January.


